X. UNFINISHED BUSINESS

A. Medicaid Expansion Resolution

Isaiah Knight made a Motion to adopt a Resolution "Recommending Retention of Medicaid Focus on the Most Medically Vulnerable Virginians and Commending Virginia Lawmakers for Fiscally Responsible Opposition to Medicaid Expansion." The Motion was seconded and discussion was allowed. Knight withdrew his Motion and made a Motion to Amend the Resolution, striking outdated language. The Motion was seconded and approved with unanimous consent. Knight made a Motion to approve the amended Resolution. The Motion was seconded and failed with 11 votes in favor, 7 against, and 2 abstentions.

B. Appointment of 2nd District Representative

Chairman Thota recommended the appointment of Andrew Hull as YRFV's 2nd District Representative. The Recommendation was seconded and approved with unanimous consent.

XI. REPORT FROM THE CAMPAIGN COMMITTEE

Vice Chairman Turner presented a report on behalf of the Campaign Committee, on which he presides as Committee Chairman.

XII. NEW BUSINESS

A. Pride Month Resolution

Evan Draim introduced a Resolution "Recognizing June as LGBT Pride Month." Chairman Thota made a Motion to limit debate to 3 minutes on each side. The Motion was seconded and approved with unanimous consent. Chairman Thota opened the floor to debate. Isaiah Knight made a Motion to table the resolution. The Motion was seconded and failed with 20 votes against and 4 votes in favor. Draim made a Motion to adopt the resolution. The Motion was seconded and approved with 19 votes in favor and 5 against.
